Lehigh Valley Memories: A Tour of the Lehigh Valley in New York's Finger Lakes Region 1941-59 by David Marcham '53, railfan, former LV employee, retired railroader. 88 pages, soft cover, 8½ x11, with 135 illustrations, including maps, \$19.95.

The Gangly Country Cousin: The Lehigh Valley's Auburn Division by Herbert V Trice, one of the deans of Lehigh historians. 160 pages, soft cover, 8½ x11, with 190 illustrations from the 1860s to 1990s and six new maps of the 315-mile rural division that ran to Ithaca, from Sayre PA to Fairhaven on Lake Ontario and from Elmira to Camden NY, \$24.95. Edited by John Marcham '50, as are the other three.

A History of the Railroads of Tompkins County, Third Edition, by H.G. Lee, LLB '48, expanded by Winton Rossiter '78 in 1977 and John Marcham '50 in 2008. 96 softcover pages 5½ x 8½ with a 20x30 annotated map of all rail lines, \$12.95. This well researched book traces the lineage of the Lehigh Valley, Lackawanna, and 50 other local railroads. 43 photos and illustrations.
